- Overall stock levels have risen steadily since April, up+11% over the last three months and +1.3% MoM.
- The amount of bikes with under 20k miles on the clock has also increase for the third month running, up +1.4% MoM.
- Bikes priced over £19,999 were the only price band that saw stock decrease MoM.



Stock of bikes under 2 years old has been steadily declining since the start of the year with those aged 5 - 10 years old seeing the biggest increase.




#### Indexed stock volume - by price

Stock levels of bikes with under 20k miles on the clock increased for the third month running, up +1.4% MoM.



Average stock volume was up +1.3% MoM and +11% since April this year.

- Of the top five makes only Yamaha saw a decline in stock levels albiet a small one, down -0.2% MoM.
- The Triumph Tiger has overtaken the Yamaha MT as the most stocked bike this year.
- The amount of bikes sold fell across all price bands MoM with those priced over £19,999 (small volumes) seeing the biggest drop, down -29%.



Prices fell across all selected make and models with the exception of the Yamaha MT which was up +0.78% MoM.


