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#### September 2024 at a glance


- Overall stock levels are down -1.4% MoM, with bikes priced under £5,000 the biggest faller, down -6.5%.

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#### Stock volume by dealership


Overall stock levels are down -1.4% MoM.


#### Indexed stock volume by age

Stock levels for all age bands are up MoM, with bikes aged over 10 years old the biggest climber, up 4.7%.




#### Indexed stock volume by price

#### September 2024 at a glance

- Average bike prices were down across all age ranges, with those aged between 2 and 5 years old, down the most at -2.6% MoM.
- Average prices fell for bikes with 20k 100k miles on the clock, while those under 20k (+1.9%) and those over 100k (+2.7%) were both up MoM.
- Ducati remained the second most expensive make behind Harley-Davidson, despite a -5.0% MoM fall in price.


#### Average price top 10 makes

Average bike prices were down across all age ranges, with those aged between 2 and 5 years old, down the most at -2.6% MoM.




#### Average price selected makes/models
