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## **Static Caravans: Stock**

## **MOTORS**

#### October 2024 at a glance

- Stock levels began falling in May, rose slightly in August but have continued to fall since then.
- As the price goes up, the stock levels come down. £5,000 to £9,999 was the only price band that saw a significant increase, up +4.4% MoM.
- All age bands saw stock levels decrease MoM with the newer static caravans (under 2 years old) falling the least, down just -0.3%.

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#### Stock volume by dealership

Stock levels began falling in May, rose slightly in August but have continued to fall since then. October saw levels down -1.0% MoM.

As the price goes up, the stock levels come down. £5,000 to £9,999 was the only price band that saw a significant increase, up +4.4% MoM.



The biggest MoM fallers were Swift static caravans, down -31.2%.

BK saw the biggest increase in stock levels, up +21.7% MoM, while the biggest fallers were Swift, down -31.2%.

## **Static Caravans: Price**

#### October 2024 at a glance

- Overall average prices are down -0.8% MoM at just over £2,200 cheaper than at their peak in March this year.
- Of our top 6 makes, only Cosalt static caravans saw a rise in average price MoM, up +2.6%.
- Newer static caravans (under 2 years old) saw average prices drop -4.0% MoM.


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#### Average price

Overall average prices are down -0.8% MoM at just over £2,200 cheaper than at their peak in March this year.



- In terms of age bands, caravans over 10 years old have been the most stocked since May.
- Stock levels for the cheapest caravans (under £5,000) were up +26.3% MoM.


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#### Stock volume by dealership



- Since average prices peaked in June we've seen a gradual fall to September then a big drop in October, down -13.4% MoM.
- The average caravan price in October was just over £3,300 down from this years price peak in June.
- Eriba have been the most expensive make of caravan all year.


#### Average price top 6 makes

- The majority of listings and ad views is for caravans over 10 years old.


