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Static Caravans: Stock

November 2024 at a glance

- As we head towards Christmas, sales slow, so overall stock levels increase, up +2.2% MoM.
- Most of the top makes saw stock levels fall or remain flat MoM, three makes though saw rises: BK +9.0%, Victory +20.1% and Swift +32.4%.
- Static caravans aged between 2 and 5 years old saw stock levels fall the most, down -13.7% MoM.

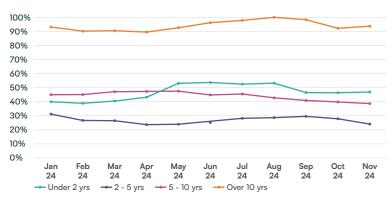

- The overall average price peaked in March (£39,182), in November that was down by £3,550 to £35,632.
- Only Cosalt in our top 6 makes showed an average price increase MoM, up +2.2%.
- Statics aged between 2 and 5 years old have had the highest average price since May, in November it sat at £66,951.

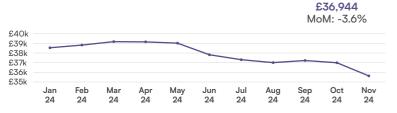

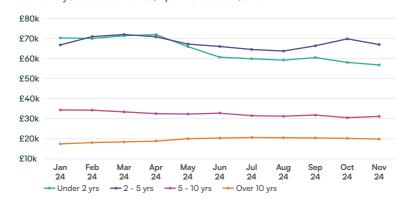
After a slight rise in September the downward trend since March continued, down -3.6% MoM.

Static Caravans: Demand

- November saw a big drop in sales of static caravans, down nearly -40% MoM.
- Ad views for Swift statics were up the most (+96.9% MoM) albeit from a small stock volume.
- It's the older statics that get the most attention, with those aged over 10 years old getting over 60% of ad views.

Unsurprisingly, as we reach the end of the year and winter is here to stay for the time being, sales of static caravans are at an all time low for the year.

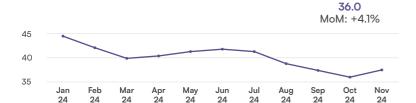

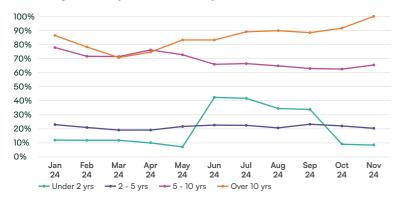

- The younger models (under 2 years old) saw the biggest MoM drop, down -15.5%.
- Despite a -6.8% MoM drop in price, Hobby are the most expensive caravans out there, with an average price of £35,721.

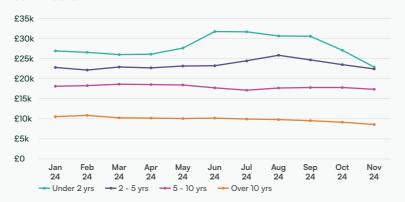

Mobile Caravans: Demand

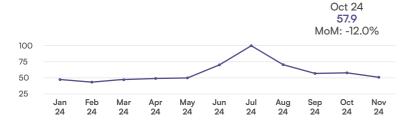
November 2024 at a glance

- November was a big month for Lunar: up 4 places to be the 4th most sold caravan make, together with a +29.0% increase in ad views.
- Caravans aged over 10 years old have the most listings and ad views by far both of which were up MoM.
